CARE AND STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS

For best performance operate your item indoors. When not in use, store this product in its original packing. Keep away from heat and moisture.

- 1. Please use the adapter supplied by manufacturer.
- 2. Please assemble item according to instructions. Connect all wires according to matching color.
- 3. Children should be supervised by adults. Item should not be grabbed, as it becomes a tipping hazard.
- 4. Keep all away from the adapter, as it heats up during operation.

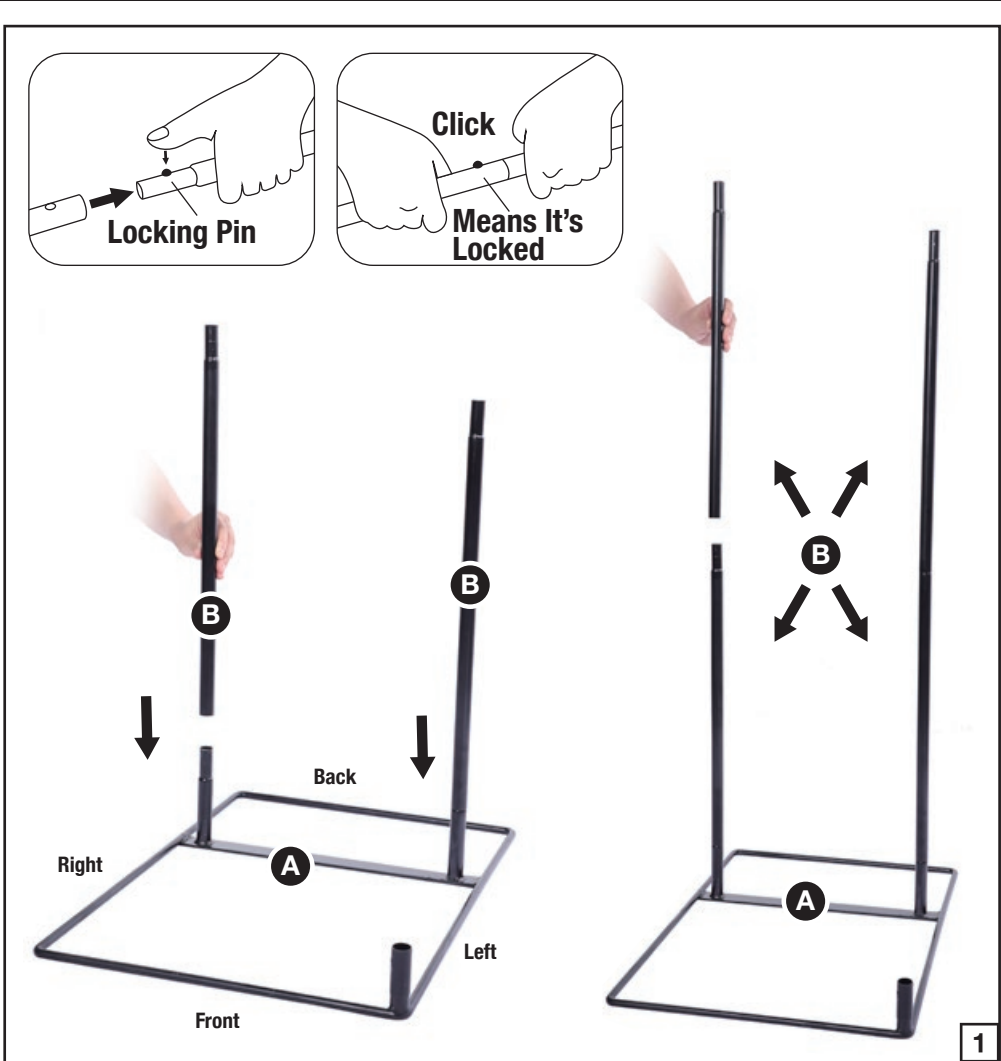

Assembly Instructions:



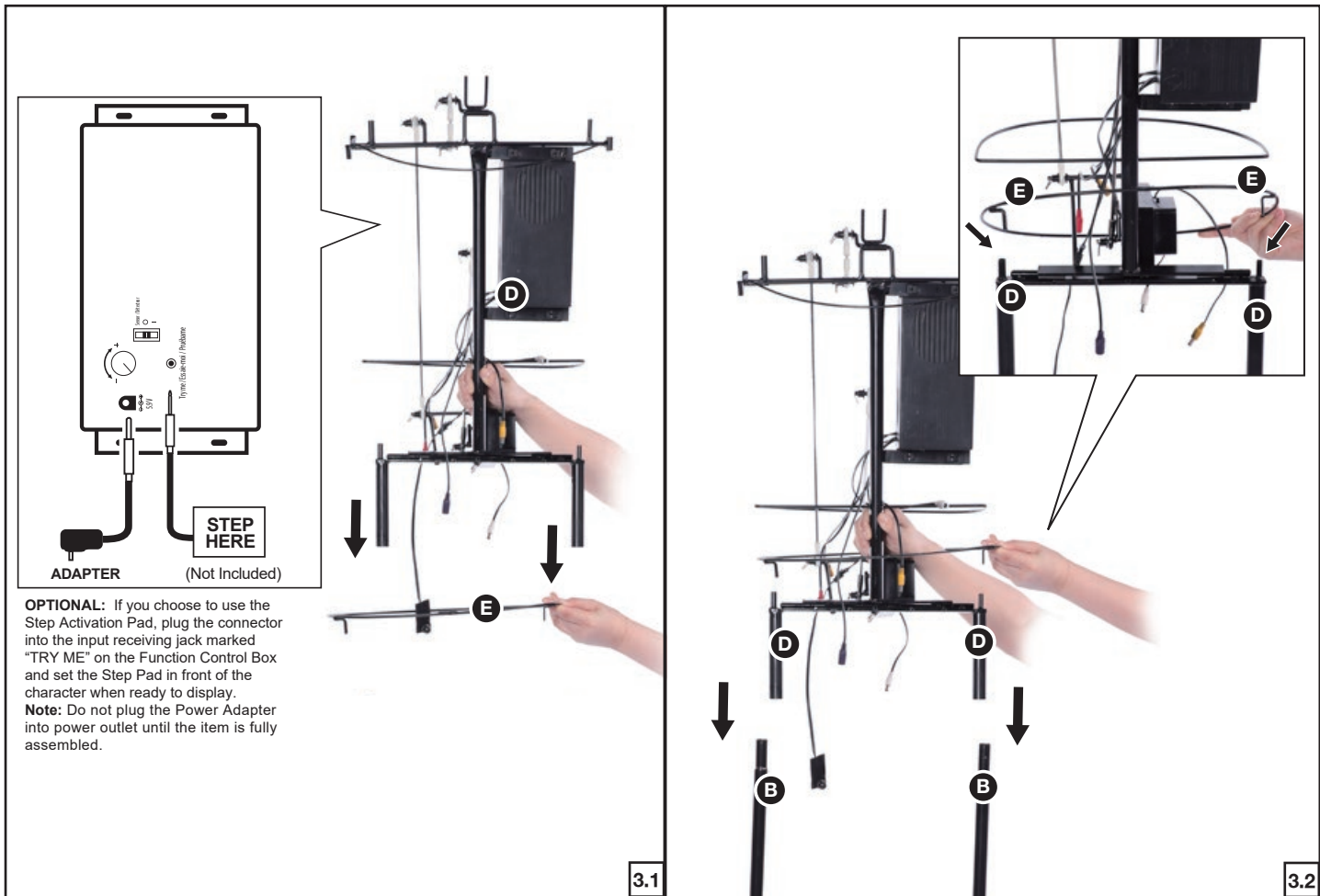
STEP 1

NOTE: Left and right are from the point of view of the character. The longer end of the (A) Base goes towards the front. First, assemble the (B) Support Poles to each other and to the (A) Base as shown, and secure by aligning the quick-connect push buttons into the pre-drilled holes.



STEP 2

Slide the (C) Costume over the (B) Support Poles as shown in Figure 2.



STEP 3
Secure (E) Hip Hoop to the (D) Body Frame as shown in Figure 3.1 and connect the (D) Body Frame to the (B) Support Poles by aligning the quick-connect push button to the pre-drilled holes as shown in Figure 3.2.



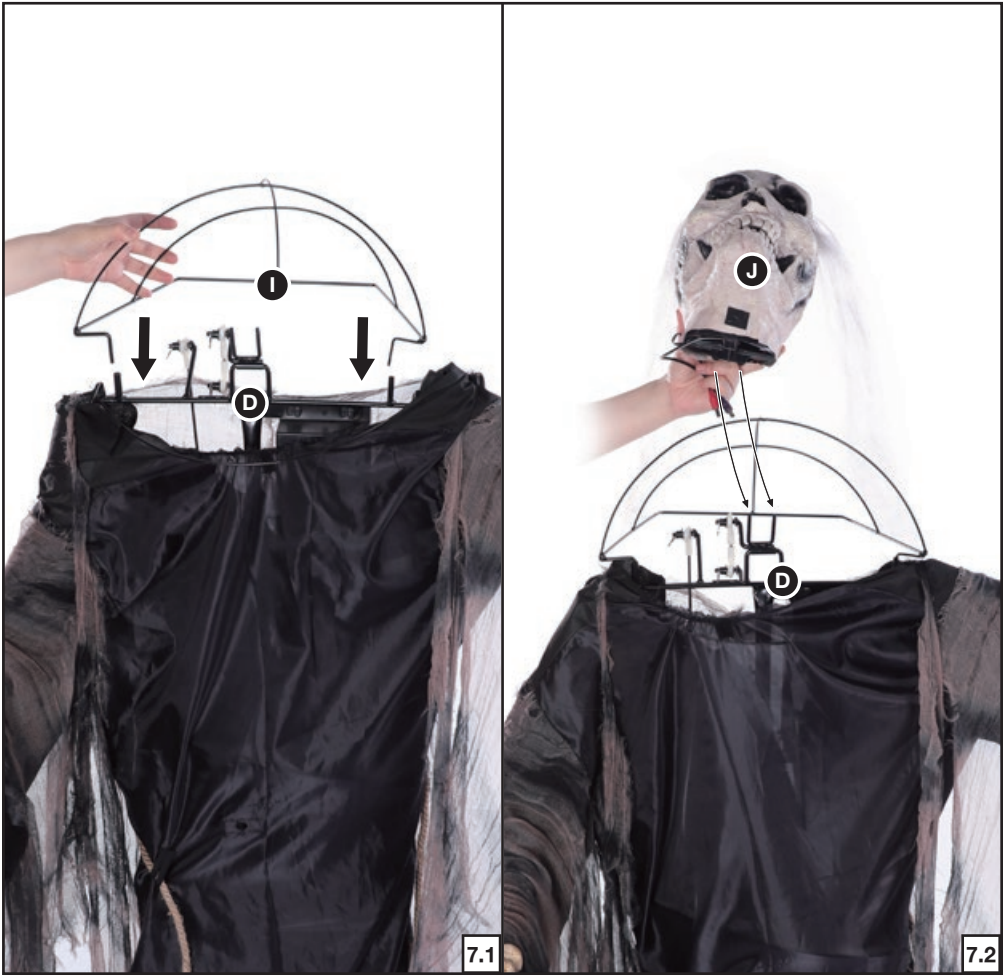
STEP 4
Bring up the (C) Costume over the (D) Body Frame as shown in Figure 4.2.



STEP 5
Slide the (F) Left Arm up inside the left sleeve of the (C) Costume as shown in Figure 5.1 and insert the available forked hook from the (F) Left Arm to the available forked hook holes on the left side of the (D) Body Frame as shown in Figure 5.2 then secure the sleeve using the hook and loop closure available as shown in Figure 5.3.



STEP 6
Slide the (G) Right Arm up inside the right sleeve of the (C) Costume and insert the available forked hook from the (G) Right Arm to the available forked hook holes on the right side of the (D) Body Frame as shown in Figure 6.1. Insert the forked hook on the (H) Right Hand to the forked hook holes available on the (G) Right Arm as shown in Figure 6.2 then secure the sleeve using the hook and loop closure available as shown in Figure 6.3.



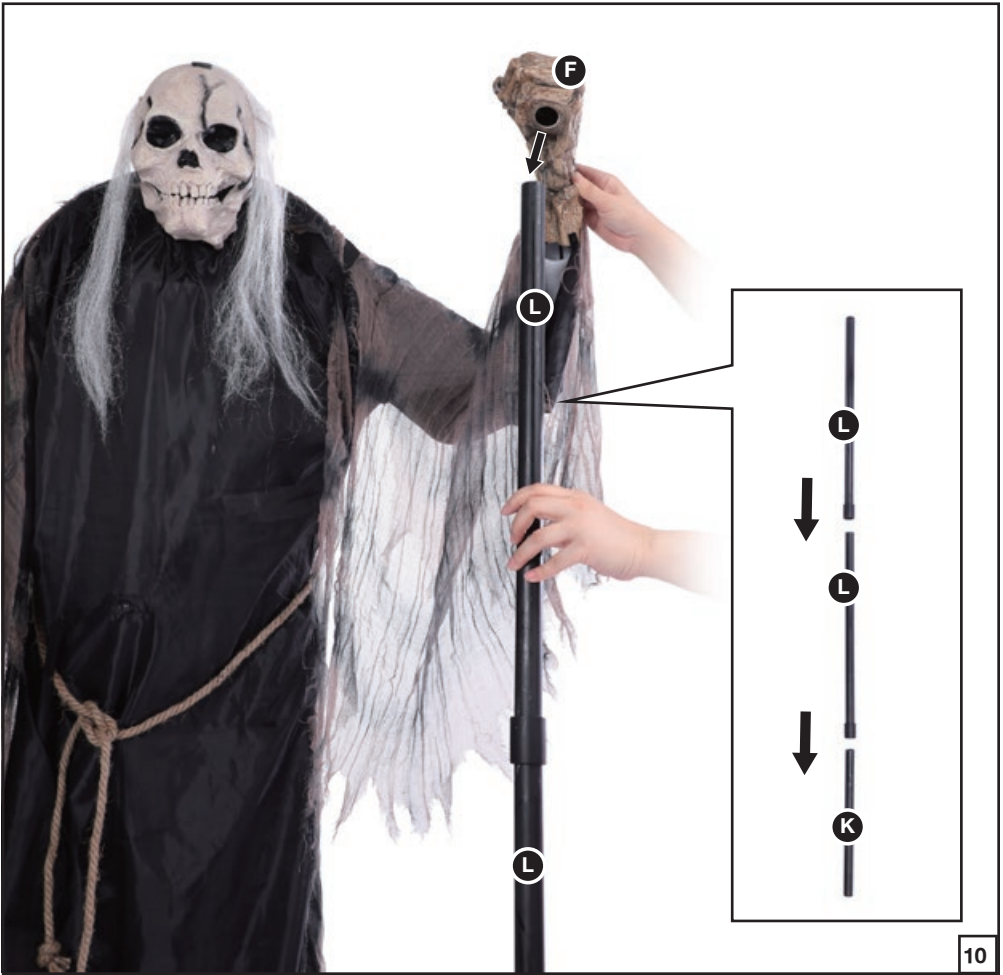
STEP 7
Attach the (I) Back Frame by inserting the prongs to the slot available on the (D) Back Frame as shown in Figure 7.1. Attached the (J) Head to the (D) Body Frame as shown in Figure 7.2.



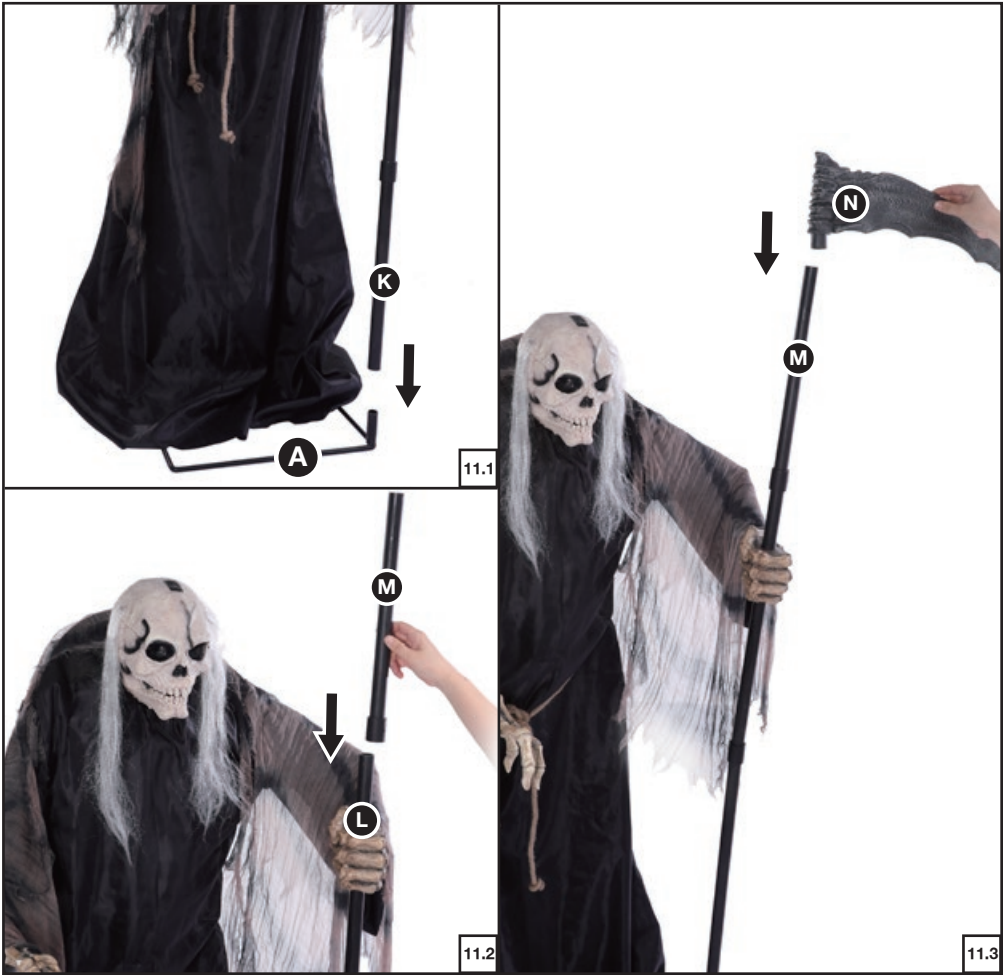
STEP 8
Secure Sensor to the sensor hole on the (C) Costume using the hook and loop closure as shown in Figure 8.1. And connect all cables from the Function Control Box to their corresponding cables by color as shown in Figure 8.2.



STEP 9
Close the back of the (C) Costume by securing the available hook and loop closures as shown in Figure 9.1. Secure the collar of the (C) Costume to the (J) Head using the hook and loop closure available as shown in Figure 9.2 and tie both of the jute belt together as shown in Figure 9.3.



STEP 10
To assemble the Scythe, connect together both (L) Middle Scythe Pole and connect them to the (K) Lower Scythe Pole and slide the assembled (L&K) Scythe Poles through slot available on the left hand of the (F) Left Arm as shown in Figure 10.



STEP 11
Secure the Scythe with the character by inserting the Scythe Poles to the peg available on the (A) Base as shown in Figure 11.1, then connect the (M) Upper Scythe Pole to the (L) Middle Scythe Pole as shown in Figure 11.2 and attach the (N) Scythe Blade to the assemble Scythe Pole as shown in Figure 11.3.



STEP 12
Slide the (O) Hood down the (J) Head as shown in Figure 12.1 and secure the (O) Hood to the (C) Costume using the available hook and loop closure as shown in Figure 12.2 then prop up and secure the (O) Hood to the (J) Head using the available hook and loop closure as shown in Figure 12.3. Your Luning Reaper is fully assembled. Plug in and turn on to let the fun begin!

OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Plug the power adapter into a standard power outlet and adjust the settings on the Function Control Box, located on the Torso Frame, as desired.
2. Settings:

Sensor	This setting allows the item to only be activated when the infra-red (IR) sensor is activated. The item will operate for one audio-cycle with each sensor activation. The Infra-red (IR) sensor will activate when someone comes within an 80-degree angle from left-to-right, as well as from above and below. The infra-red (IR) sensor has a range of up to 2 meters/6.56 feet, and can work in all lighting conditions – bright light to no-light!
O/OFF	This switch mode will turn the lights, sounds, and animation off.
I / ON	This switch mode will continually operate the lights, sound, and animation of the item.
	Raise or lower the volume using the volume control turn dial, turn all the way down to turn the volume off.
